Meeting was called to order by Kevin Thompson at 5:15.

Minutes of the July 25, 2017 Meeting were submitted for approval.

Moved by Kim Meisinger and 2nd by Buddy Miles to approve meeting minutes. All members present voted in the affirmative.

Treasurer's Report - Report made by Kevin Markowski. Club is doing well. Cash flow is good and we have not been into the line of credit. Cafe is doing very well. To view the full financial information please check in with Becky or Kristen.

Moved by Vic Shappy and 2nd by Buddy Miles to approve the Treasures Report. All members present voted in the affirmative.

Café Committee Report – Report made by Ernie Bove. Café is doing very well. The Committee will be meeting with Mark Reardon in September after things slow down to see how he feels things are going.

Finance Committee Report - Report made by Dale Laval. The Committee had a meeting on August 15. Kevin went over the financials and they looked at all expenses. Rod McPhee is working on an Ethics Policy. John Wing is looking at other restaurants to find out what they use for a food margin and also a beverage margin. The Committee reiterated that any invoice that comes into the Club must be signed off by the appropriate person before it will be paid.

Membership/Advertising Committee Report: - Report made by Kristen. The Committee is looking at new levels of Corporate Memberships and all Membership classifications for 2018. We have nine new members from our 2018 New Membership offer. 7 New Young Professionals and 2 New Single Members. Vic suggested we have a social event in the spring for new members to meet Board Members, learn about tournaments, and Men's and Woman's nights.

We have a lot of painting that needs to be done, light out in parking lot that needs to be repaired, maintenance building needs work, caddy shack needs a new roof, and we have stairs that need to be repaired. Vic suggested we come up with a painting rotation for the clubhouse and pro shop.

Pro/Cart Committee Report – Report made by Buddy Miles and Greg Nelson. We need to put something on the bridge going from the 5th tee to the 5th green to stop people from slipping. Dave Prior can come up with material to fix this.
